What are Teachers Schedule will look like

- Morning Meeting-Check-in, Attendance, Pledge, Read Aloud
 - Benchmark Reading-Whole Group
 - Break, Small Group instruction, and Asynchronous Work
 - Lunch
 - Eureka Math-Whole Group
 - Break
 - Social Studies/ Science
 - Check-Out
 - Specials

Asynchronous work includes-IXL, Zearn, Social Studies Weekly, and any other assignment the teacher will provide.

Expectations for your child during the school day:

- ★ Independence/Personal Responsibility
 - This includes:
 - Asking for help when they don't understand something
 - Sitting in a work space where they can work and focus (no laying in bed or relaxing on the couch)
 - Keeping distractions to a minimum in the learning environment (TV, food, side conversations with other family members...)
- ★ Engagement and Participation-every day! Focused on lessons and assigned websites
 - Not using other websites during instruction
 - Keeping camera on
 - Trying personal best and actively participating (speaking and listening) during lessons

Expectations continued....

- ★ Organizational Skills: having all materials ready and following directions when they are given
- Respectful behavior (to self and others at all times)
- ★ Safe and appropriate use of technology

EACH STUDENT IS EXPECTED TO...

- Participate in learning and review assignments.
- Adhere to the DPS Code of Conduct.
- Advocate for him/herself with teachers.
- Respond to email communications from his/her teachers via the district email or Schoology.
- Be respectful to him/herself, classmates and staff.
- Be honest and complete his/her own work, cite sources and not plagiarize or google during tests.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS-ZOOM CAMERAS

- Student cameras MUST be on and the student's face clearly visible during all instructional time.
 - If a student cannot be seen on camera, the teacher will move the student to the waiting room. After several minutes, the student will be readmitted to class.
 - If the student still cannot be seen on camera, the student will be removed from class and marked absent.
 - Repeated issues will require a meeting with the principal or assistant principal.

Parent Expectations

- Parents are expected to make sure their child(ren) are available for virtual school each day and monitoring their activities throughout the day.
- Parents are expected to encourage students to participate during lessons respectfully.
- Parents are encouraged to provide their child(ren) a quiet spot for the live lessons as well as a quiet spot to complete any assignments.
- Parents are encouraged to contact the teacher with any problems or concerns. (Dojo, Remind, or email etc.)
- Parents are asked **not** to interrupt online learning when the students are with the teacher.
- Parents are asked to avoid being on camera when learning is going on.
- Parents are asked to report their child(ren) absence

Attendance calls will be made.

Truancy will be filed for excessive absences.
